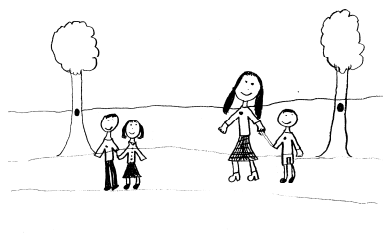
The school will do its best to:
