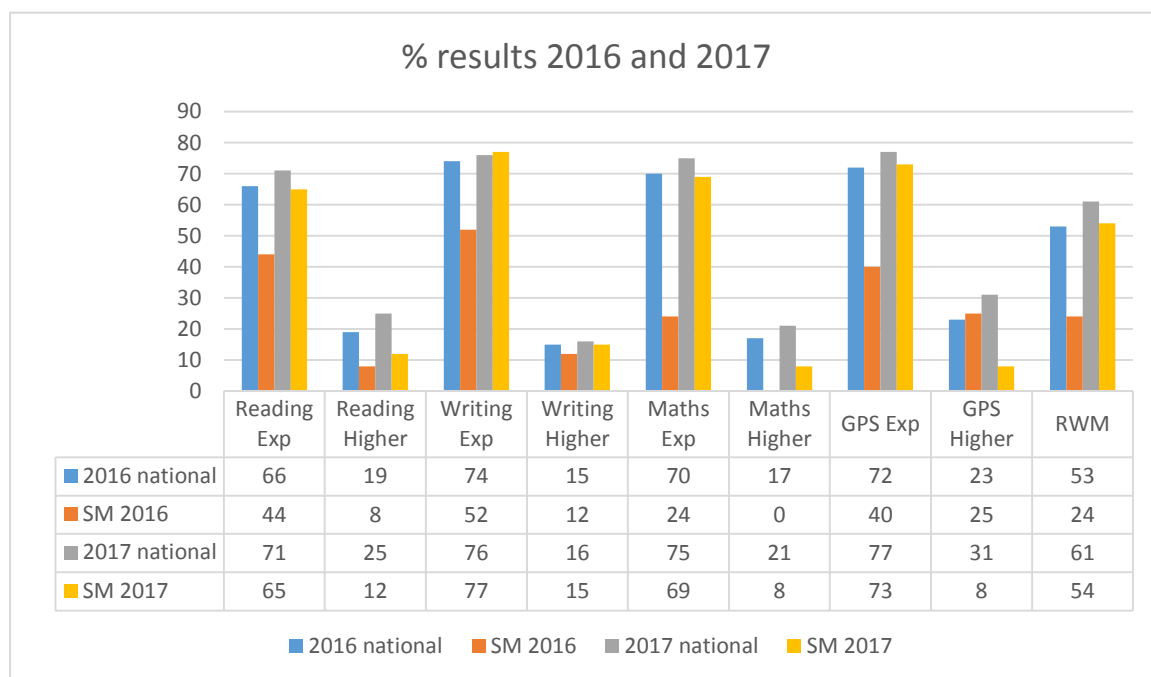


KEY STAGE 2 RESULTS FOR ST MARY'S PRIMARY SCHOOL

St Mary's Primary School are really pleased with their results in 2017. This year group was well below the national average in terms of their ability but they achieved broadly in line with the national average in all subjects. This meant the pupils made excellent progress.

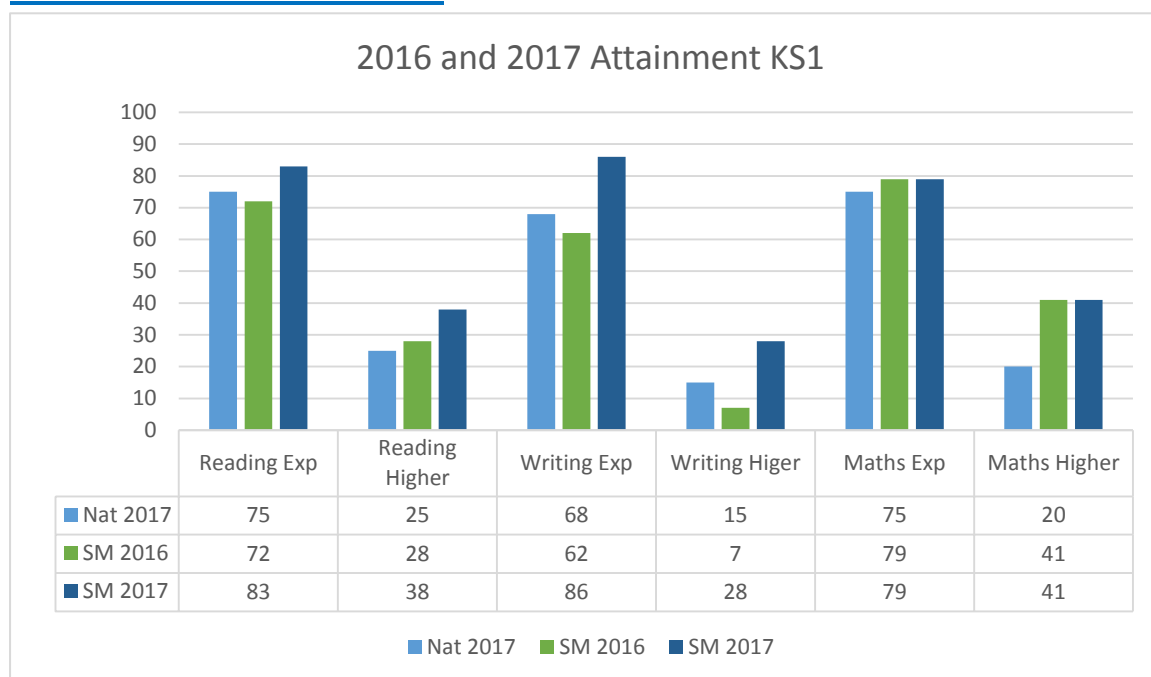

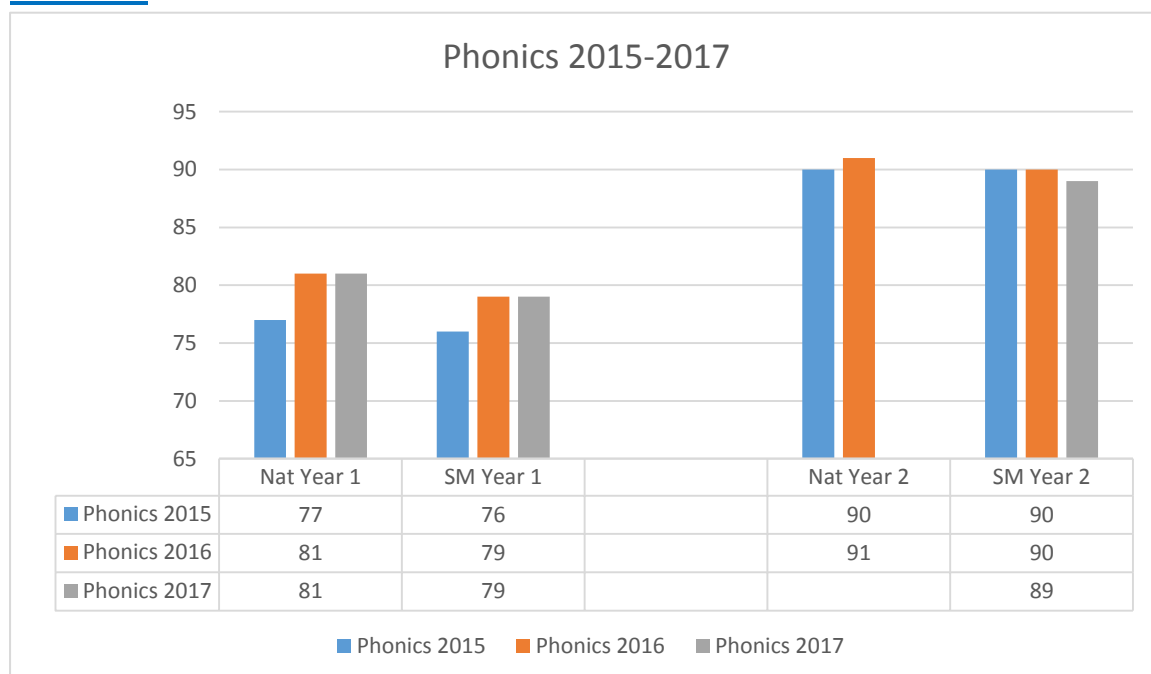
In 2017 there was a significant improvement in progress in both Writing and Mathematics. The Writing results are now in the top 25% of schools nationally and the Mathematics in the top 40% of schools. This was a very good performance by these children and the school. 54% of pupils achieved Expected standard in Reading, Writing and Maths combined.

RESULTS IN KEY STAGE 1



Results in Key Stage 1 were outstanding and showed a significant improvement on those of 2016. They were above the national average in each subject at both Expected standard and Higher level (or Greater Depth).

Phonics



Phonics continues to be very effectively taught and results remain broadly in line with the national average. Overall the school was very pleased with these results and aims to be in the top 30% of schools nationally in all subjects.
