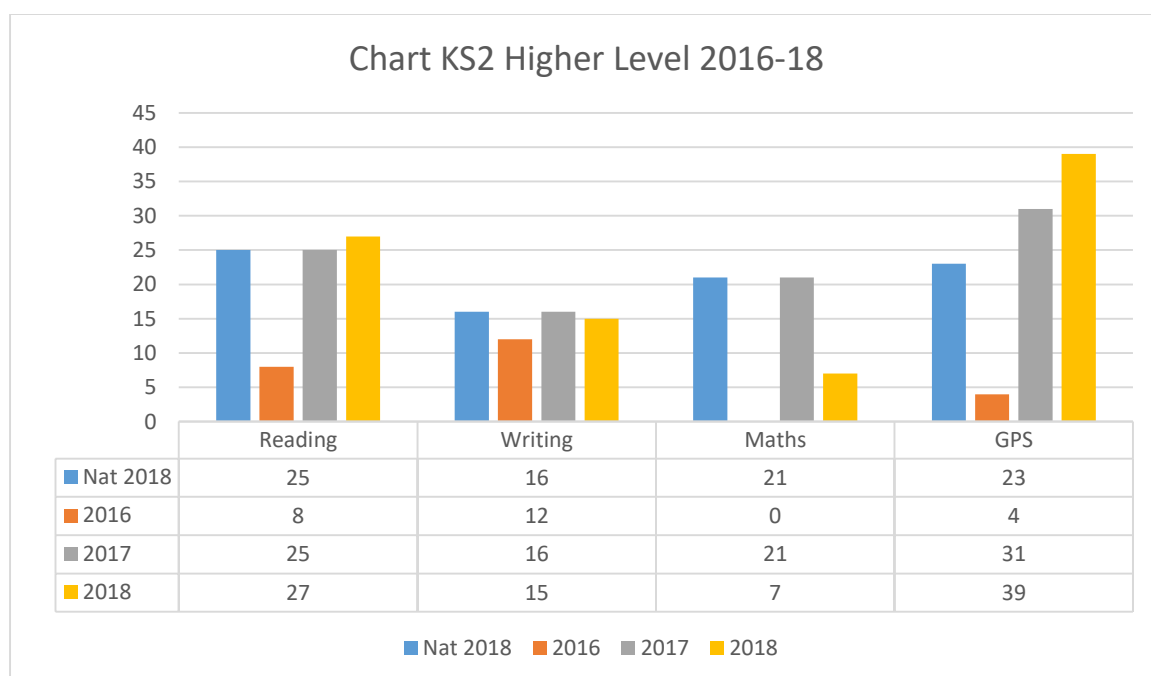
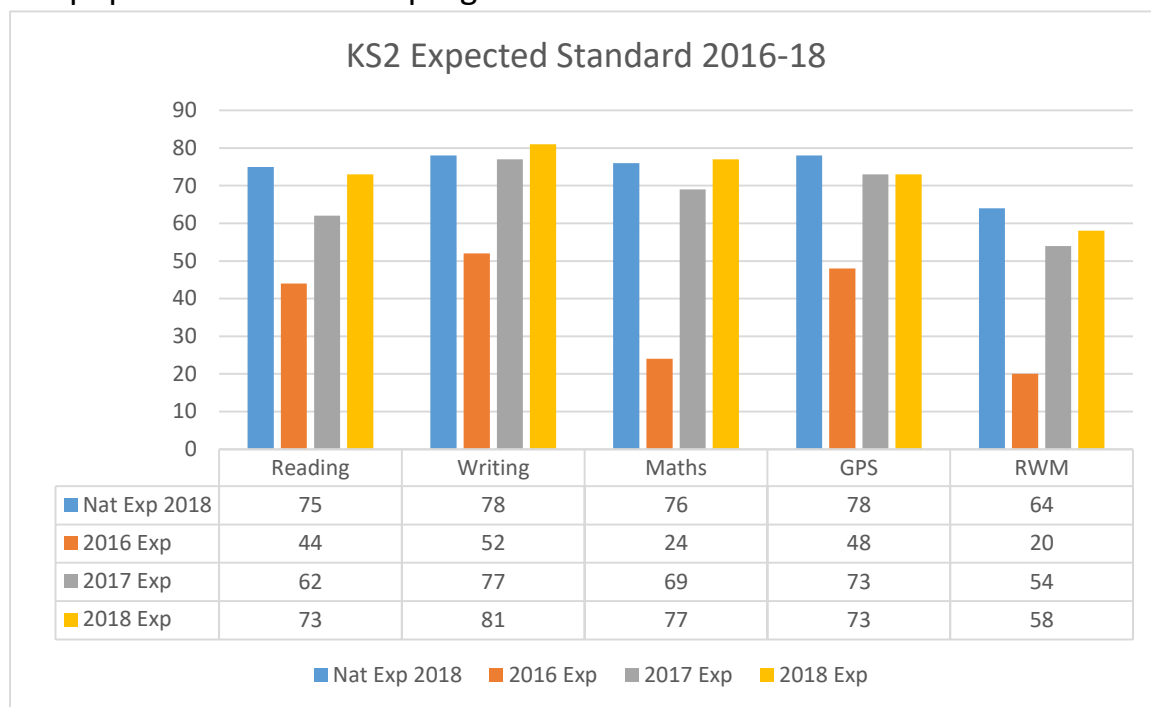


KEY STAGE 2 RESULTS FOR ST MARY'S PRIMARY SCHOOL

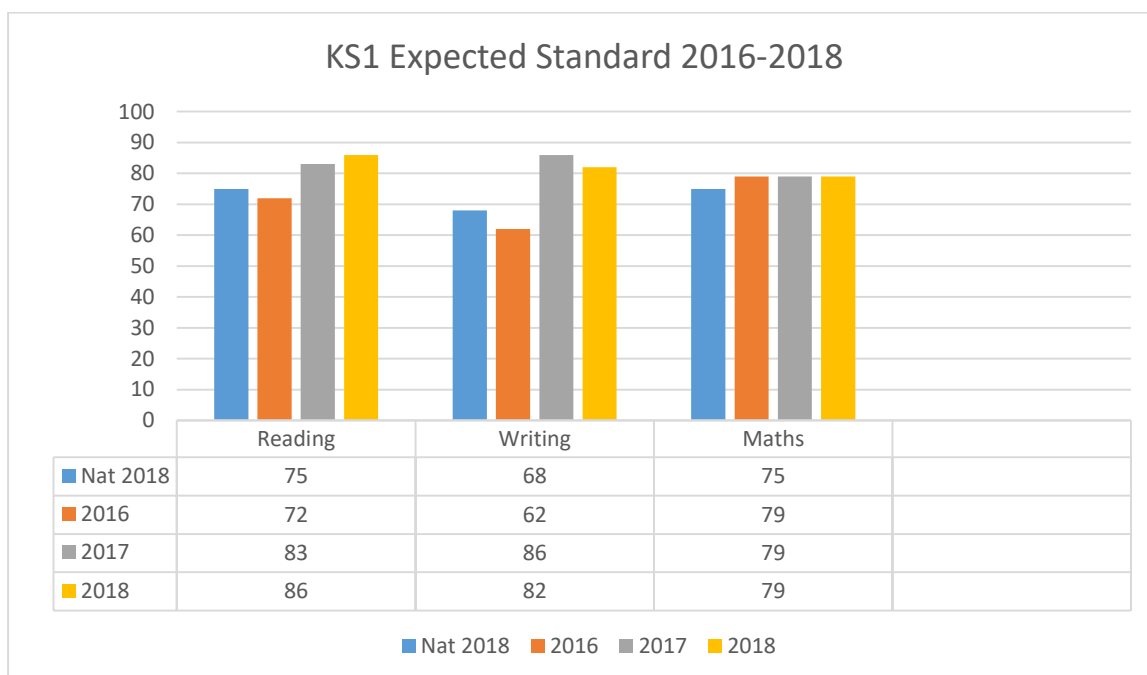

In terms of progress in comparison to national performance tables, Reading and Writing were above average and Maths is average.

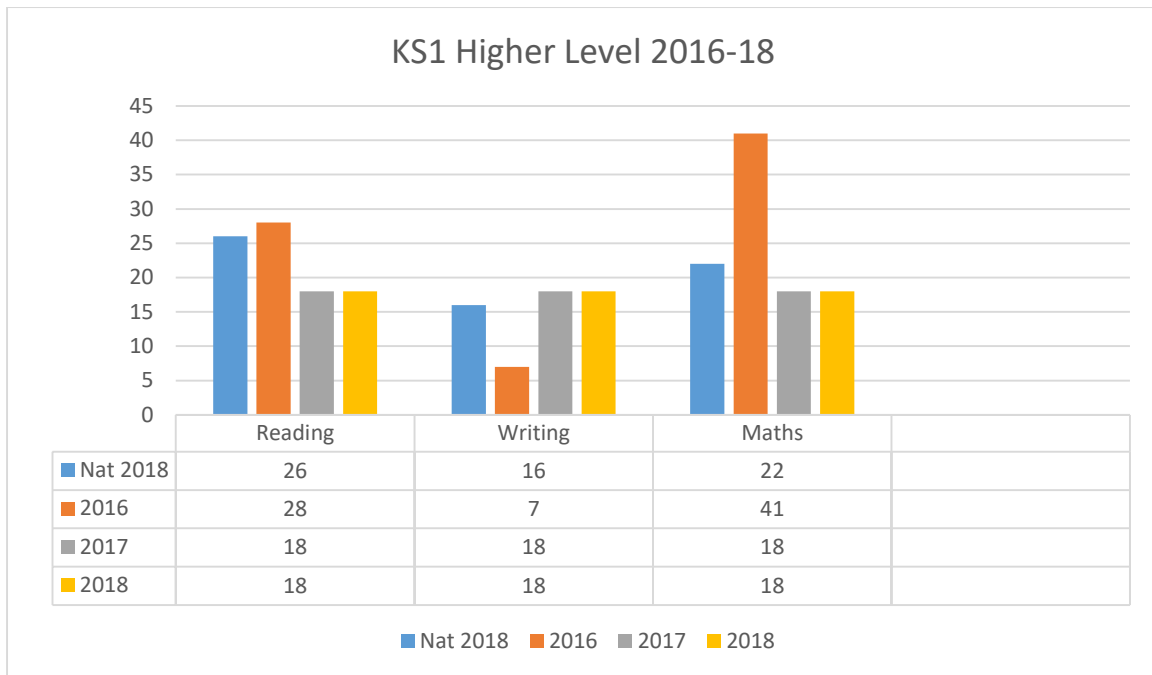
Scaled scores were: Reading 104.2 Writing 102.2 and Maths 102.2

RESULTS IN KEY STAGE 1

Key Stage 1 results remain a strength of the school as they have been for several years.



All three subjects were above the national average and Reading and Writing and well above at expected level.



Phonics

Phonics continues to be very effectively taught and results remain broadly in line with the national average. Overall the school was very pleased with these results and aims to be in the top 30% of schools nationally in all subjects.
