<p><b><u>Literacy:</u></b> Our first literacy topic for this half term we will be having a visit from a policeman to write a recount about. Our next topic is writing a narrative based on Stanley's stick which we will link to our walk to the apple orchard. Our final topic is elves and we will be creating non-chronological reports on them.</p>	<p><b><u>Science:</u></b> Science this half term will also carry onto next half term and we will be looking at different materials.
