

Fire Safety Visit

Reception enjoyed a visit from Rose who is part of the Fire Safety Education Team. Rose taught the children lots about the fire service, their role and key things to remember. The class were split into teams or 'watches' just like the real fire teams in Weymouth. Each group had a key message to teach the rest of the class.

Blue Watch taught the class what to do if there is a fire and we are inside
'Get out, Stay Out, Call 999.'

White watch taught the class about the dangers of matches and lighters
'Matches lighters never touch they can hurt you very much'

Red watch taught the class what to do if you are on fire
'Stop drop and roll'

Green Watch taught the class about fire alarm and how you should get low if you can smell smoke.
The class really enjoyed the visit and learnt lots though discussion and acting out key ideas.

At the end Rose gave each child a sheet with all that they had learnt and some pictures for colouring, a pencil and a class Bear call Blaze to look after. The class are all very excited to have Blaze Bear over to their house for a sleepover.
